APPLICATIONS WILL BE TAKEN IN SEPTEMBER, DUE OCTOBER 1, 2018.

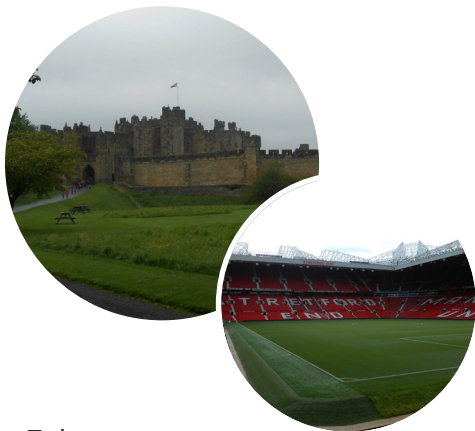

Gain exceptional knowledge from an international view of livestock, crop sectors, food markets, government policy, and historical and cultural points of interest within England and Scotland. Visit USDA staff from the Foreign Ag Services in London, Leicester Raceway, a dairy operation in Coventry and a Blackface sheep farm in Edinburgh, Scotland. Explore the Tower of London, Coventry Cathedral, Alnwick Castle, Manchester United Stadium and so much more!

- **Cost is approximately \$3400.** Includes airfare, ground transportation, some meals, most – if not all – admissions, lodging, and travel insurance.
- **Easy payment plans available.** The earlier you sign up, the smaller the payments!
- **Agriculture from a global perspective:** experience livestock and crop markets from an international view. Invaluable industry experience awaits you from London, England to Glasgow, Scotland.
